8th Nov 20 - 10.45am assemble

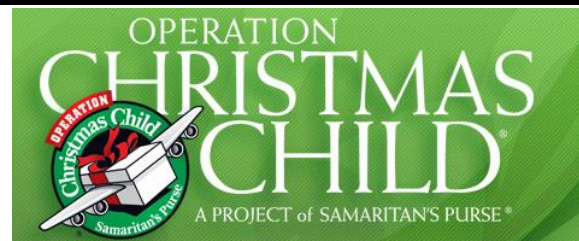
This years Remembrance Services at St Marks and St WYSTANS will take place outside.
