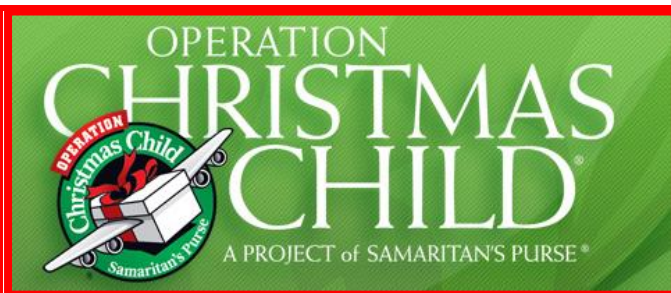

Remembrance Sunday

8th Nov 20 - 10.45am assemble

This years Remembrance Services at St Marks and St Wystans will take place outside.

They will hold all the same elements that of our regular Remembrance Sunday Service, except they will be outside. So we will be standing throughout.

If it is wet please bring an umbrella.

St Marks: we will gather in the Church Yard on the South Side (Church Hill Street Side) There will be an amplification system because of the size of location.

St Wystans: we will gather on the Green around the Memorial. If wet the ground can be a bit sticky, Wellingtons might be a good choice.

All Covid rules apply: 2 metre distancing between groups, Rule of Six, No Singing, Track and Trace. We also ask that people wear face coverings.

If you normally attend either of these services you will be very welcome.
