


## Remembering

### War Memorial

*Micah 4:1-5*

the house of the God of Jacob; that he may teach us his ways and

between many peoples, and shall arbitrate between strong nations  
far away; they shall beat their swords into ploughshares, and their  
spears into pruning-hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against

under their own vines and under their own fig trees, and no one shall  
make them afraid; for the mouth of the Lord of hosts has spoken.  
For all the peoples walk, each in the name of its god, but we will walk
